APPOINTMENTS

We offer face to face appointments, telephone consultations and video consultations. Please be aware that there are certain symptoms that the doctors would need to see you face to face and can't be dealt with over the telephone. Home visits are for the frail and truly housebound patients only. Please only request a home visit if you are unable to get to the surgery. If you do need a home visit, please call the surgery to request this before 10.30am. Our practice has suitable disabled access for our patients.



The recent rollout of the Accurx software allows patients to complete an online triage form which will then be considered and triaged by one of our GPs on the same day. Accurx is helping to reduce the number of unnecessary appointments whilst also allowing our GP's to decide on the right needs for you and everyone else. Our online triage is open from 8am to 10.30am Monday to Friday and can be found on the practice website.
