The HCAs offer blood clinics for patients by appointment. They also offer health screening to identify problems which may lead to heart disease, stroke, diabetes and kidney disease. If you are eligible for a health check you will be invited to attend once every five years.

Services

Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm

Screening is available for men aged 65+. This involves a simple ultrasound test which is quick, painless and non-invasive with results provided immediately. Please see posters inside the surgery entrance or visit aaa.screening.nhs.uk for more information.
